A museum director is responsible for many aspects of operations including budgeting, fundraising, and financial controls, programming and exhibition development, and maintaining and researching the collection.

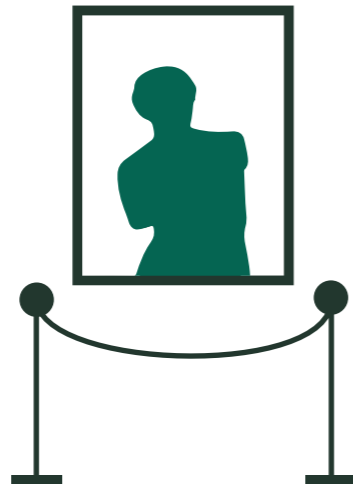

### Exhibit Designer

Exhibit display designers design and produce exhibitions for museums, galleries and libraries. This may also include private businesses, specialist trade events and conferences, and large commercial public events.

### Historian

Historians are academics and researchers who study events of the past. Their main duties include collecting historical data from libraries, archives and artefacts, determining the authenticity of historical data and teaching or researching at universities.

### Library Director

A library director hires ,trains , and schedules library staff. Cooperating with the board, community officials, and groups in planning library services and publicising library programs.

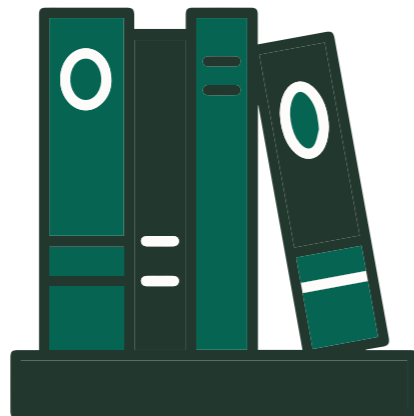

Library Assistants help librarians in the management and operation of a library. Their primary duties include helping customers locate books and other items, checking books in and out at the front desk and shelving books according to their categorisation.

### Architectural Technologist

Architectural technicians work very closely with architects and other building professionals, providing architectural design services and solutions on construction projects. They negotiate projects, assessing the needs of clients and users, and agree the project brief.

### Building Control Surveyor

A building control surveyors job is to make sure that building regulations and other legislation are followed when houses, offices and other buildings are designed and constructed. They also check that property alterations, such as extensions and conversions, meet regulations.

## CAD Technician

A CAD technician uses CAD software to create technical drawings and plans - also known as draughting - for products and parts used in the engineering, construction and manufacturing industries.

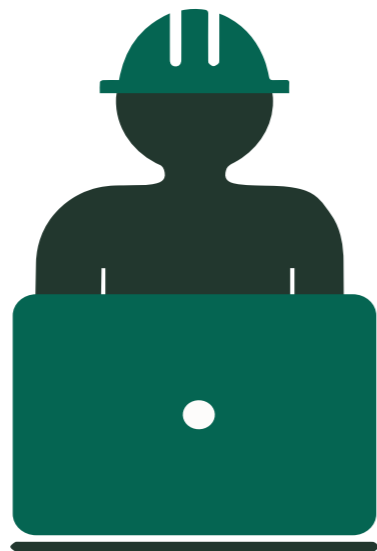

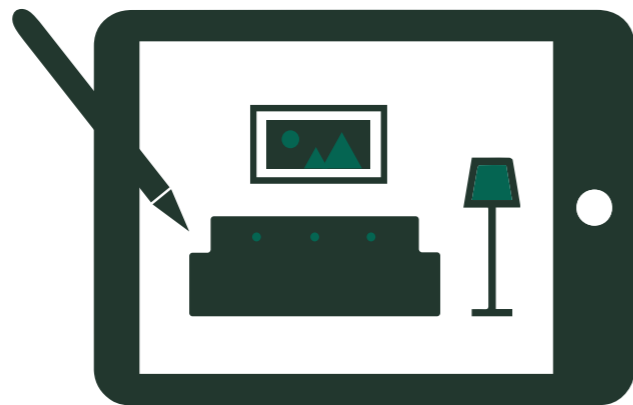

### Town Planner

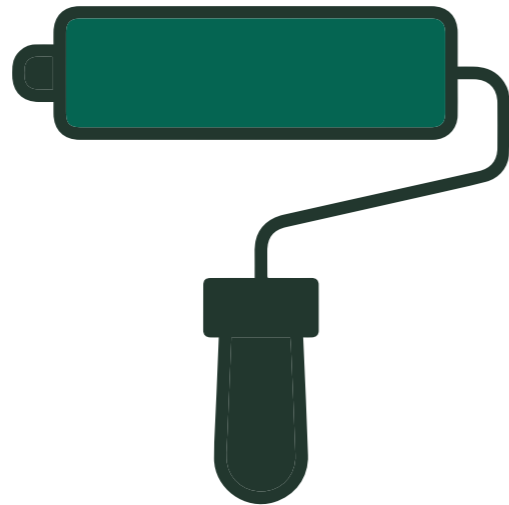

### Retail Buyer

A fashion retail buyer is responsible for sourcing, developing and introducing product ranges that suit their stores and customer base. Visiting fashion shows and trade fairs to look for new products. managing stock levels. negotiating prices, quantities and delivery time-scales.

## Retail Manager

Retail managers are responsible for ensuring their staff give great customer service as well as monitoring the financial performance of the store. Typical responsibilities of the job include: training ,recruiting, supervising and appraising staff. ... dealing with customer queries and complaints.

## Retail Merchandiser

A retail merchandiser is responsible for ensuring that the right amount of goods are available in store and are being sold at the right price. This also means working closely with buyers and other merchandisers to plan product ranges. meeting with suppliers, distributors and analysts.

### Stylist

Fashion stylists work for individuals, fashion houses and clothing brands. Their main responsibilities include providing fashion advice as well as choosing and co-ordinating outfits for models in photo shoots or actors in television and film. They can also help choose props and accessories whilst preparing them for shoots.

### Textile Designer

Textile designers are mainly involved in coming up with innovative ideas and developing commercially appealing designs. This includes prints for a variety of fabrics, clothing and non-clothing materials, furnishing materials, industrial fabrics and other related materials, using both natural and manmade fibres.

### Visual Merchandiser

A visual merchandiser defines , designs and implements a creative visual merchandising strategy. Creating appealing and eye-catching visual displays that lead the customer through the entire store. Producing window displays, signs, interior displays, floor plans and special promotions.

### Teacher/Tutor

The responsibilities of a drama educator include creating lesson plans, teaching students about plays and assisting students in creating their own dramatic pieces. They will also help organise and manage the learning environment whilst directing performance rehearsals.

### Actor TV/Film

An actor's primary duty is to effectively communicate the character that they are playing to an audience. They will use their voice, body, actions and reactions. Through their art, actors tell stories, engender emotional reactions in their audience and make people think.

### Actor Theatre

Actors express ideas and portray characters in theatre, film, television, and other performing arts media. They will interpret a writer's script to entertain or inform an audience.

### Painter/Artist

Artist and painters provide artistic support for company advertising and/or organisation promotional efforts. Develops, sketches, and/or prints creative ideas for a variety of mediums.

### Choreographer

A choreographer is very similar to the director and the screenwriter of a film, all rolled in to one, but for dancers and dance routines instead of actors on screen. They can create and plan the routines for performers to play out, usually to music or to evoke some sort of idea in the heads of the audience.

### TV Presenter

A TV presenter entertains and informs an audience by presenting information or entertainment in an accessible and attractive way. They introduce or host a programme, create links between items, introduce and interview guests and interact with the audience.

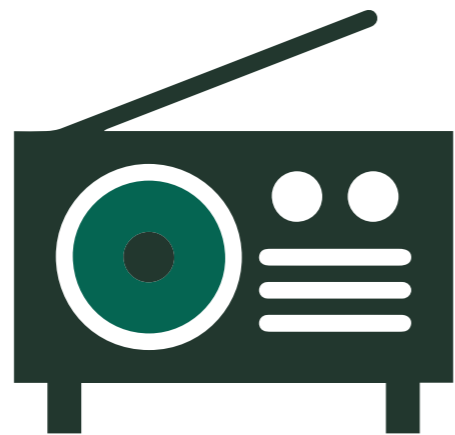
